WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT TURKEY?

Country :

The Republic of Turkey is in the Northern hemisphere and the country belongs to Europe, but mostly Asia. Georgia, Armenia, Greece, Bulgaria, Azerbaijan, Iran, Iraq, and Syria are the bordering countries and the Mediterranean Sea is to the South; the Aegean Sea to the West; and the Black Sea to the North.

History:

Earliest records of Turkish people show their ancestors lived in Central Asia some time before 2000 BC.

By the 10th century, most Turks adopted the religion of Islam. Some Turks travelled southwest to Anatolia (Asia Minor) considered the cradle of civilization because it has embraced more than 20 cultures and civilizations. These civilizations included the Hittites, Assyrians, Lydians, Greeks, Persians, Macedonians, Ionians, Romans, Byzantines, and Turks.

In AD 1071, the Seljuk Turks conquered over the Byzantine Empire but after their influence declined, Anatolia fragmented into many smaller states. Ottoman Turks unified these separate states and became the largest empire in recent history.

The Ottomans ruled for more than six centuries (1081 - 1922), mostly without competition because they allowed flexibility and diversity in religion, language, and culture. Upon being on the losing side in World War One, their empire was due to be carved up among the Allies but a man called Mustafa Kemal Ataturk, led the Turkish people in a War of independence (1919-1922).

Occupying forces were pushed back and in 1923, the Republic of Turkey was established. As the leader of a new nation, Ataturk created foundations for a modern, secular state based on human rights and fundamental freedoms. After World War II, Turkey, became a member of NATO, OECD, the Council of Europe, and other major Western organizations.

Visa & Border Formalities

Most visitors buy a “sticker visa” at the airport, maritime port, or border-crossing point. Ensure your passport is valid for at least 90 days until the expiration date or you may not be admitted. You can obtain your visa in advance; before you arrive in Turkey, from any Turkish consulate, but it entails time, trouble, and extra expense (you’ll pay a “visa processing fee.”) Although it costs slightly more money, you can avoid queues by purchasing an e-visa (www.evisa.gov.tr)

Health & Insurance

You will need to pay for any medical treatment which you receive in Turkey. For this reason it is advisable to take out medical insurance before traveling. It is not difficult to find English-speaking doctors in all but the most remote areas. There are also foreign run hospitals in many of the larger towns and resorts. There are pharmacies in most places with trained pharmacists who are able to offer advice on minor illnesses. Many more medicines are available over the country.

Currency & Money Exchange

The currency used in the country is Turkish Lira and available in the following denominations: Banknotes: 5,10,20,50,100 and 200 TL Coins: 1, 5, 10, 25 & 50 kurus and 1 TL. Usually, cash can be exchanged without charging commission in exchange offices, banks or hotels. Cash point machines (ATM) are available in most areas, which accept major European credit and cards and give instructions in English. It may be a good idea to inform your bank in advance that you are travelling to Turkey as some will automatically put a stop on cards after the first usage in an attempt to combat fraud. Exchange rates are published daily in Turkish newspapers and the internet. If you are planning to exchange currency back from TL before leaving the country, or are making a major purchase, which may need to be declared to customs, you will need to keep your transaction receipts in order to show that the currency has been legally exchanged.

Voltage

Those who use 110 V or any other than 220 V at home need a converter as Turkey has 220 V power systems. Please check your electric appliances before you use them in your hotel room. Only the five stars deluxe properties would have converters so it is advised to bring one with you in case it is needed.

Working Hours & Public Holidays

Offices and banks are generally open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM from Monday to Friday, with a break between 12:30 to 1:30 PM. Touristic shops, restaurants and bars usually open till late night. Official holidays are;

- Apr 23 National Sovereignty and Children’s Day
- May 19 Ataturk Commemoration and Youth & Sports Day
- Aug 30 Victory Day (victory over invading forces in 1922)
- Oct 29 Republic Day (anniversary of the declaration of the Turkish Republic)

Please note: The dates of the following two religious festivals change according to the Muslim lunar calendar and thus occur 10 days earlier each year.

- **Ramazan Bayrami / Sugar Feast:** Three-day festival when sweets are eaten to celebrate the end of the fast of Ramazan.
- **Kurban Bayrami / Sacrifices Feast:** Four-day festival when sacrificial sheep are slaughtered and their meat distributed amongst the poor, neighbours and within the family

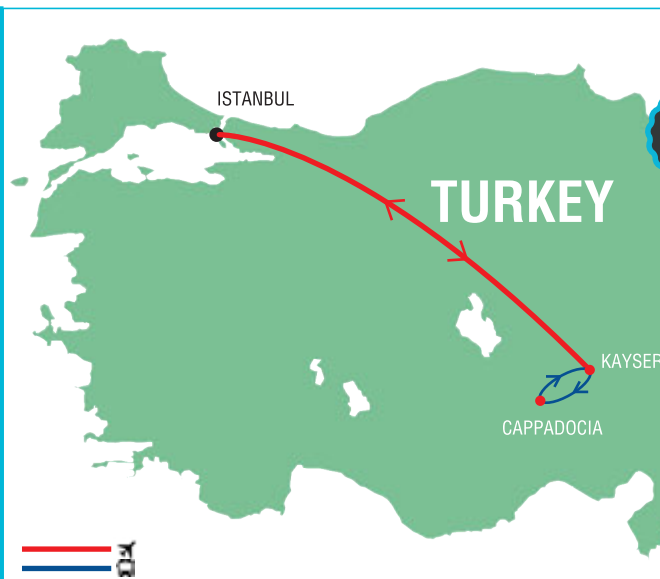

Istanbul - Cappadocia

Early pick up from your hotel in Istanbul and transfer to the airport. You will take a direct flight from Istanbul to Kayseri, which is about 1 hour. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to Cappadocia where you will join the tour starting with visits to Devrent and Pasabagi valleys, to see the amazing fairy chimneys of Cappadocia.

Then head to Avanos, which is a famous pottery town. Observe the potters at work using kick wheels, the technique which has remained unchanged for generations. Also on the agenda is the Goreme Open Air Museum, home of the world's most important Byzantine cave churches and the best-preserved cave wall paintings and frescoes. Finally, visit Uchisar castle, the highest point of the region, which has a fabulous panoramic view over Cappadocia.

Also known as, the Dardanelles Strait, Gallipoli is the notable region of a failed invasion by Allied forces during World War 1. Thousands of men died and their bravery is commemorated at nearby Anzac Cove, particularly popular with Australians and New Zealanders who annually visit on the 25th of April for morning services. Nearby is the famous archaeological site of Troy, the city that fell when invading Greek forces hid men inside a large wooden horse and sent it as a gift. Due to its 4000 years of history, Troy is an official UNESCO World Heritage site. It is possible to visit Anzac Cove, Troy and the Gallipoli battlefields in one day from Istanbul, but it is a long and tiring agenda so we recommend an overnight stay.

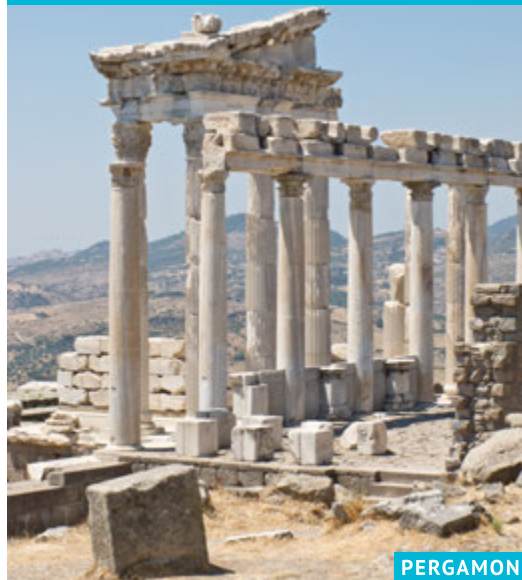

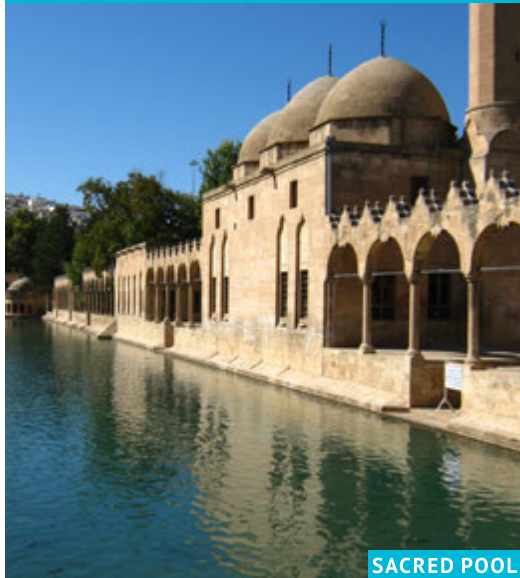

HARRAN

The imposing stone heads at the top of 2,150-metre-high Mount Nemrut are one of Turkey's most iconic sites. The statues of Greek and Persian gods were thirty-three foot tall and formed part of the tomb and temple complex built by Antiochus I (69-34 BC), who reigned over the Commagene kingdom. On this tour, you will also see urban life of South Eastern Turkey including the beehive houses of Harran and the religious site of Balıkligol. This tour departs daily from Cappadocia.

DAY
1

Cappadocia / Kahta

You will be picked up from your hotel in Cappadocia and drive to Kahta passing through Kayseri to see the Seljuk Karatayhan Caravanserai on the famous Silk Road. We will stop at the Taurus mountains for lunch and also in Kahramanmaraş, that is famous for the best ice-cream in Turkey. Finally arrive in Kahta and check-in our hotel. **(Lunch, Dinner)**

DAY
2

Mt Nemrut / Sanliurfa / Gobeklitepe

Enjoy an amazing sunrise between the colossal size statues and heads of the kings and gods at Mount Nemrut. Then visit

Arsemia, the capital of the Commagene Kingdom, the Bridge of Septimus Severus over the Cendere river, and the Karakus tumulus where members of the royal family were buried.

Drive to Sanliurfa and visit Gobeklitepe before lunch. Then we will visit Abraham's Cave and the Pools of Holy Carp. Finally drive to Harran village, where Abraham spent the last years of his life. We will see Mud-Brick "beehive" houses mentioned in the book of Genesis. Stay overnight in Sanliurfa. **(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**



GÖBEKLİTEPE

DAY
3

Birecik / Cappadocia

After breakfast we depart from Sanliurfa to Birecik which is famous for its bald-ibis (Kelaynak) birds. These birds only live in Birecik and their population is very small so we will visit the breeding farm of Bald Ibis birds. After lunch, we will drive through the Taurus Mountains and drop you off at the hotel in Cappadocia. **(Breakfast, Lunch)**

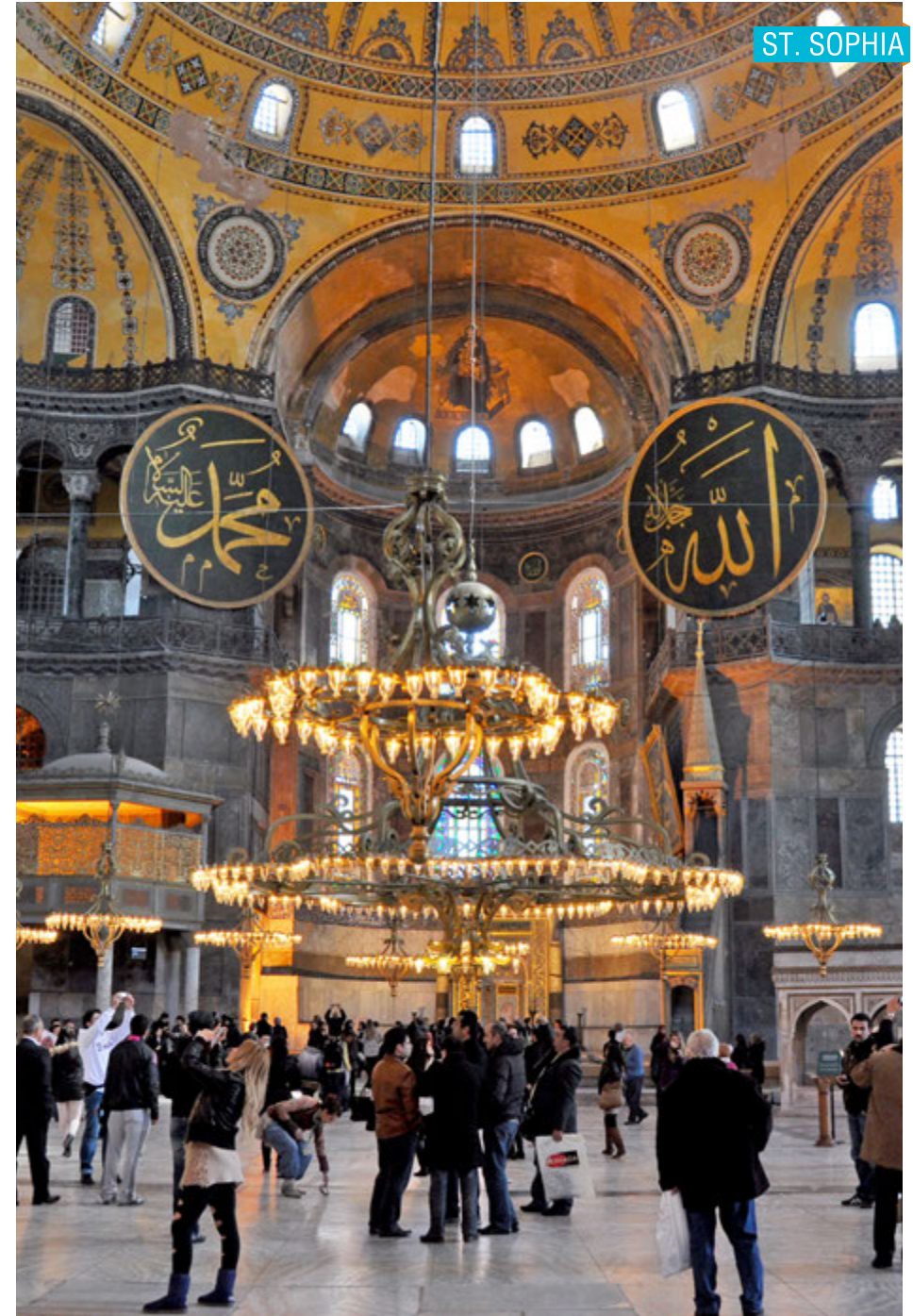

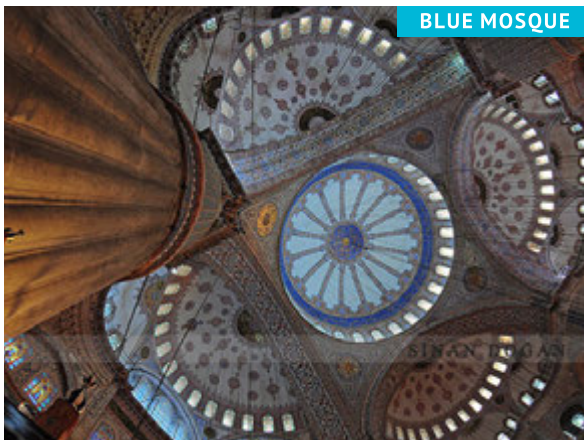

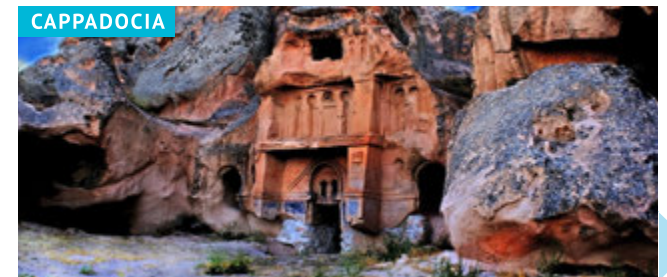

Christianity in Turkey and The Journey of St PAUL

Turkey is a predominately-Muslim country yet many people are surprised to learn its history is steeped in Christianity, from the house of the Virgin Mary in Selcuk, near ancient Ephesus to the earliest known church in Antakya.

HOUSE OF VIRGIN



Biblical tours of Turkey are very popular with visitors from Christian countries, keen to learn more about how Christianity grew in this area to spread worldwide.

Indeed, three saints of the Christian religion are called the Cappadocia fathers, due to their involvement in spreading the word even when faced with certain death. Another Saint was Paul who was born in Tarsus, present day Mersin in the Southeast of the country.

He was a Jew, and originally persecuted followers of Christ until in his own words;

he experienced a miracle on the road to Damascus.

From there, he vowed to spread the word. It is said that without people like the Cappadocia fathers, Saint Paul and John, Christianity would never have become as popular as it did.

SEVEN CHURCHES OF REVELATION TOUR

All the 'Seven Churches' of Apocalypse are seven major churches of Early Christianity, as mentioned in the New Testament Book of Revelation and written to by John the Apostle.

In Revelation, on the Greek island of Patmos, Jesus Christ instructs his servant John to: "Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus, and to Smyrna, and to Pergamos, and to Thyatira, and to Sardis, and to Philadelphia, and to Laodicea. "Churches" referred to the community of Christians living in each city, and not merely the building in which they worshipped.

Smyrna / Pergamon
